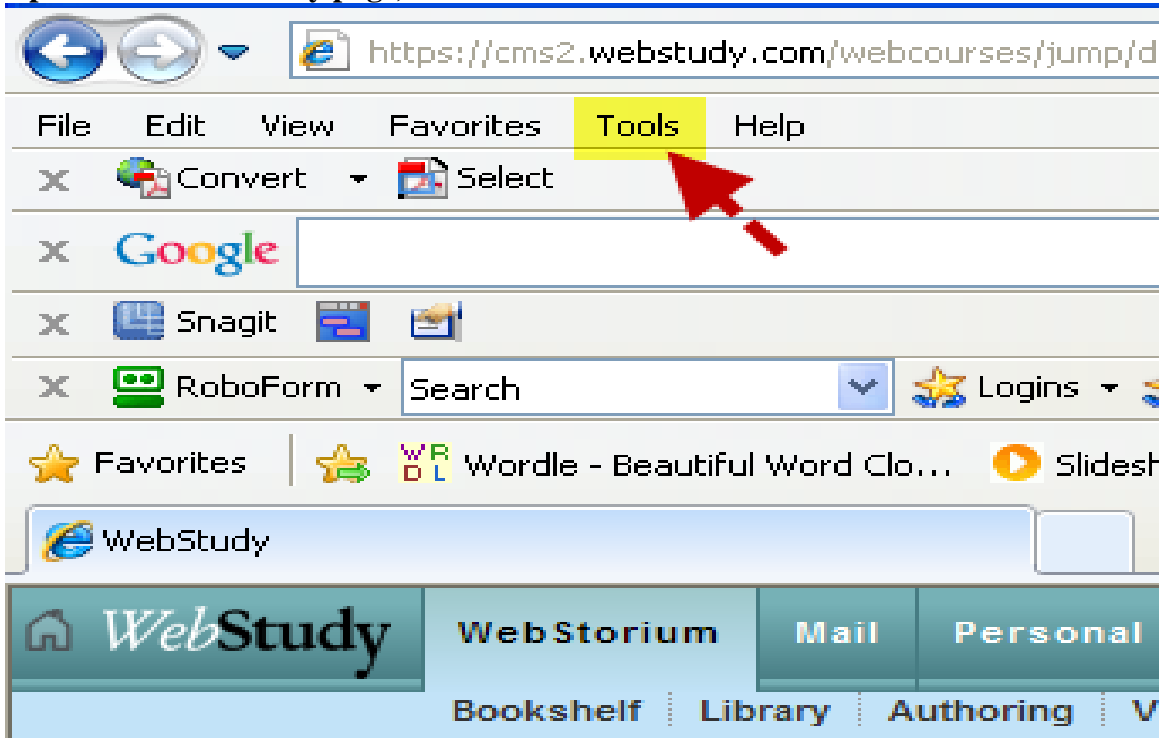


Setting Internet Explorer Security to Display All Class Content

When Internet Explorer pops up a question "Do you want to display only secure items on the page?", and you answer "YES" to the question, then what you actually do is instruct your own browser not to display certain items which were not encrypted.

Many pages may have such items i.e. pictures, links, videos, or even text pasted from a non-secure site. To correctly reset this option on a permanent basis, and to stop this question from popping up again so you can have all of your class content displayed properly, do the following:

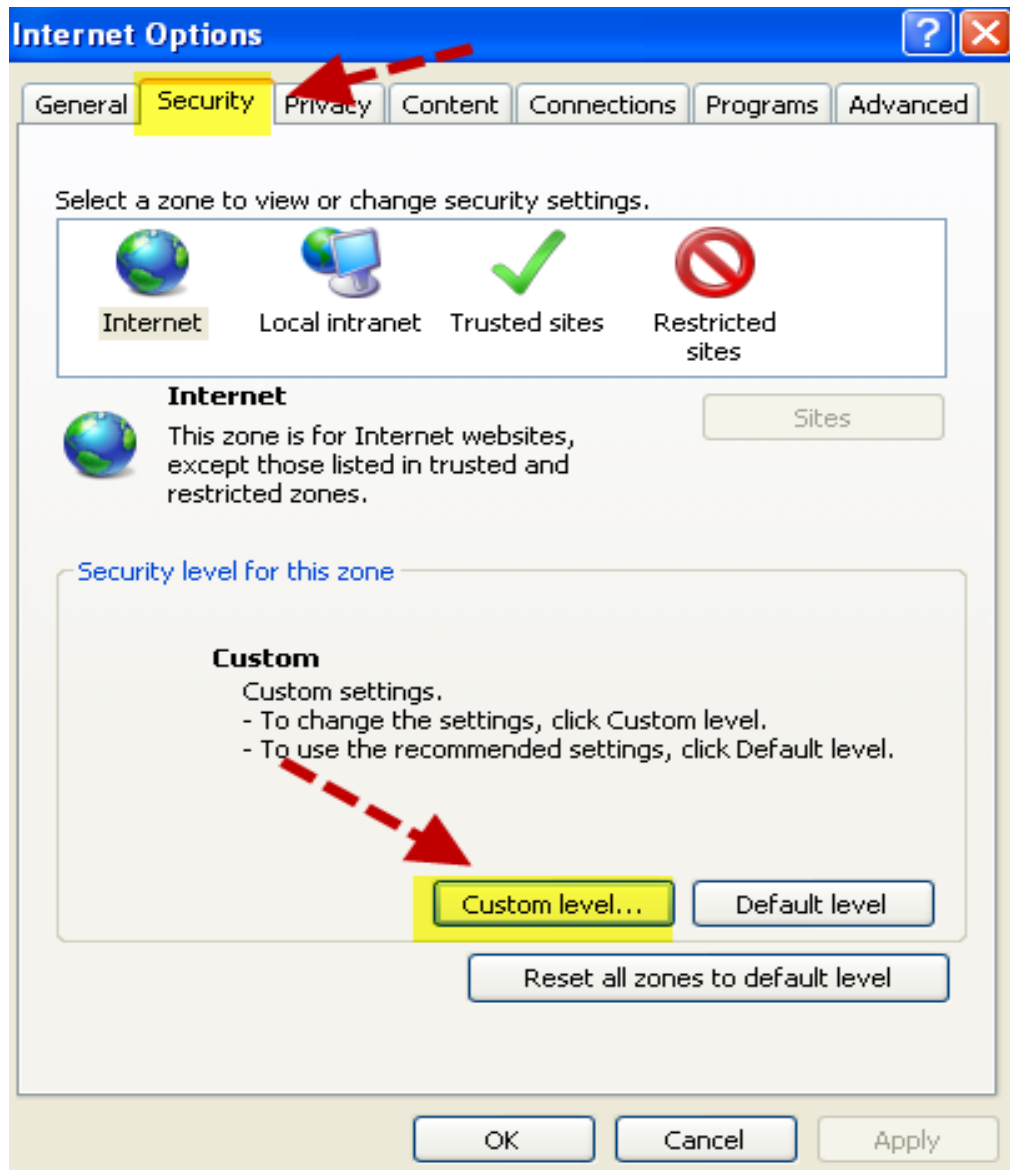
1. **On the Menu Bar of your browser click on "Tools" (this is a browser menu, and not a part of the WebStudy page).**



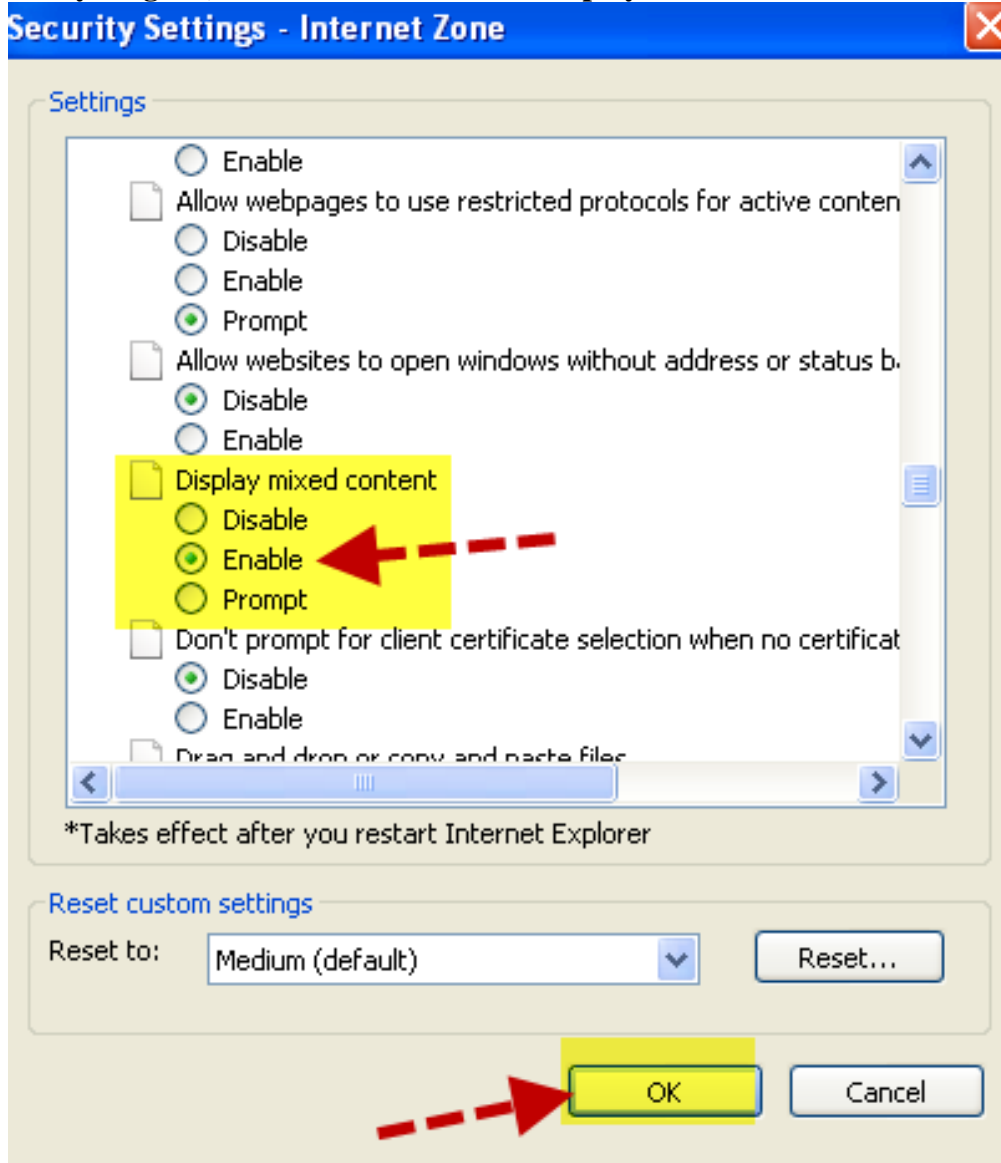
2. Click on "Internet Options".

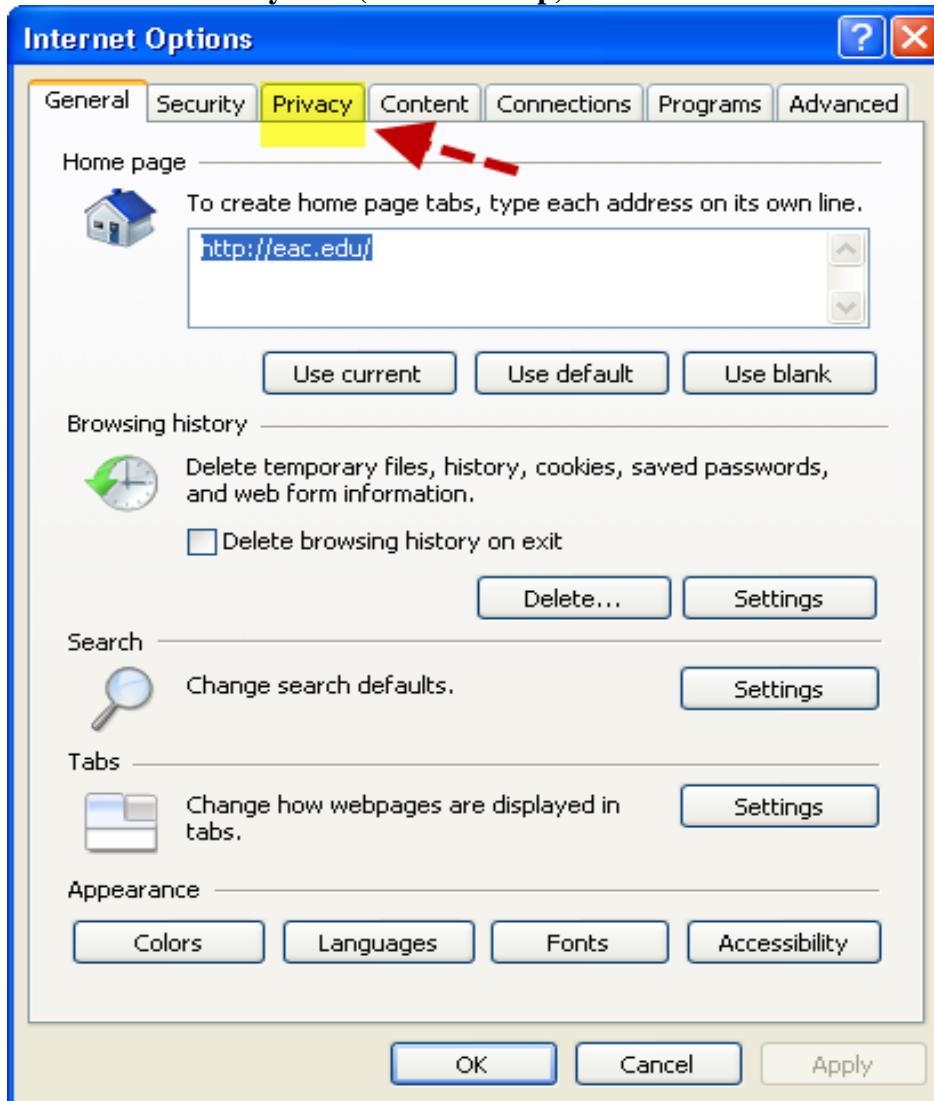
3. Click on the "Security" Tab (across the top) and then click on the "Custom level" button.



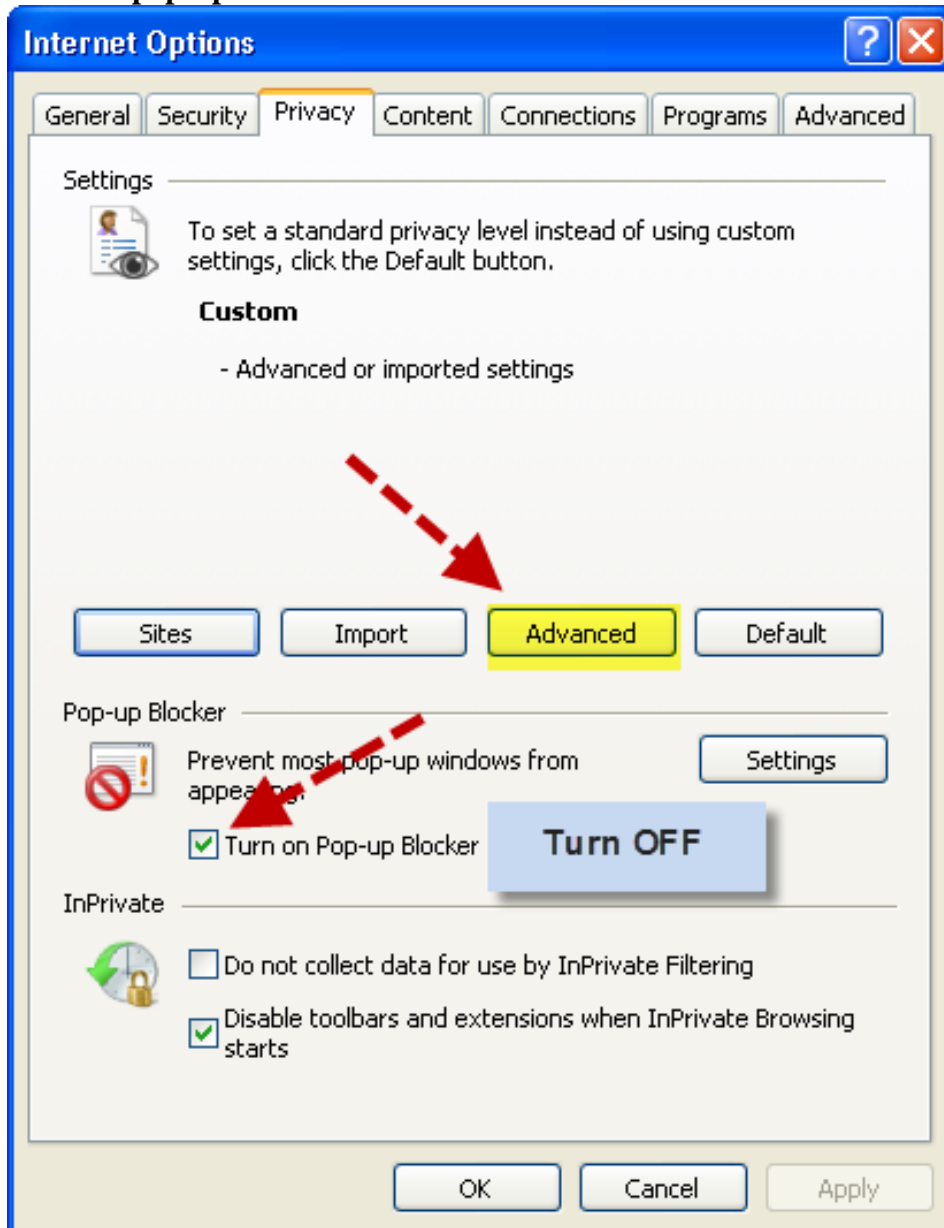
4. In the list find a section titled "Display Mixed Content" (It is about in the middle of a very long list) and select "Enable" to display mixed content. Then click OK.



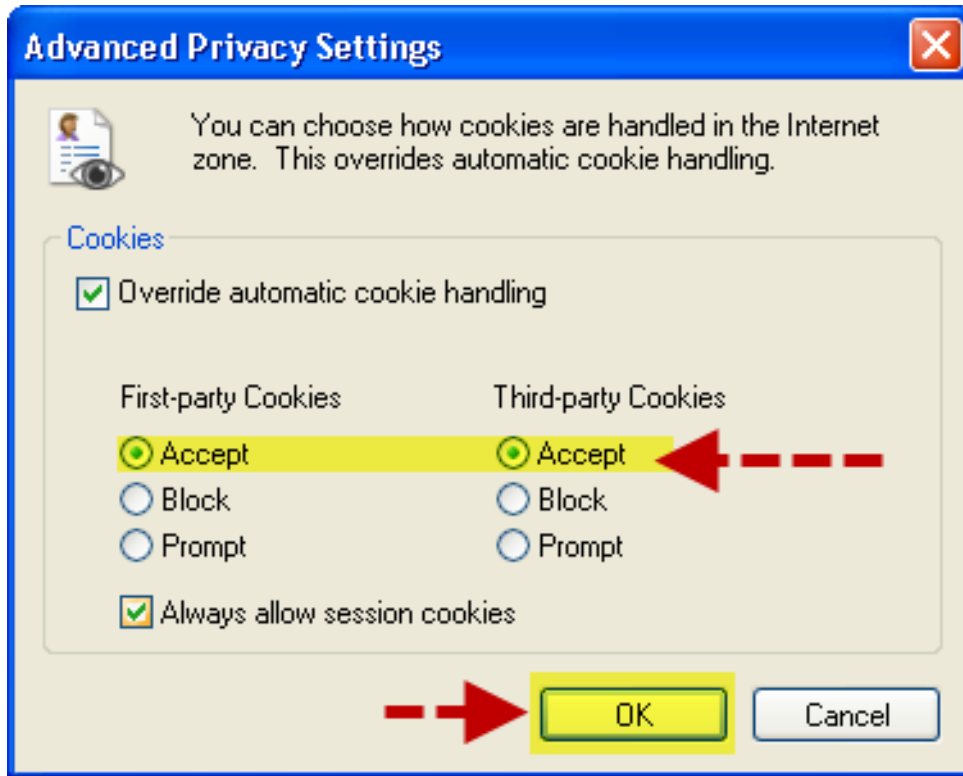
5. Click on the Privacy Tab (across the top)



6. Turn off pop-up Blocker and then click on the "Advanced" button.



7. Allow ALL cookies and then click OK.
